

RESOLUTION NO. 2033

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMISSION AND PRESCRIBING THE DUTIES THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the traffic safety problem is one of the most acute problems confronting the city administration and can only be solved by the coordinated effort of all groups and citizens of this community.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that a traffic safety commission composed of not less than five nor more than seven members be appointed by the Mayor with the consent of the City Commission, to study the traffic problem confronting this community and to work with and make recommendations to the City Commission, Police Department and Police Court.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the members of said commission shall serve respectively for terms of one, two, and three years and shall serve without compensation for their service.

The members of said commission shall select one of their number as Chairman and one as Vice-Chairman who shall serve one year until their successor has been selected. The members of the traffic safety commission shall meet at least once a month at such time and place as the Chairman or Vice-Chairman shall designate. Special meetings may be called at any time by the Chairman, or in his absence, by the Vice-Chairman. A majority of the commission shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business and a proper record shall be kept of the proceedings.

Any member who is absent from two consecutive meetings without a valid excuse from the chairman, shall automatically create a vacancy, which vacancy shall be filled by appointment of the Mayor with the consent of the Governing Body.
