Subject: NUISANCE ORDINANCE ABATEMENT AT 1742 E. 1350 ROAD

The Douglas County Sheriff's Office has received several citizen complaints regarding Alan Cobb shooting firearms at 1742 E. 1350 Road. This property is within the County but is surrounded on the south, east, and west sides by City of Lawrence residents in close proximity. Mr. Cobb has been shooting a .22 rifle in his backvard towards the east using hay bales as a backstop. While there is a small tree line in between. City residences are located less than 100 yards behind these targets.

There are currently no State or City laws which would prohibit this type of activity. There is, however, a Douglas County civil ordinance prohibiting nuisances which is applicable based upon the circumstances (HR 93-6-5). Our agency presented Mr. Cobb with a copy of this ordinance and a temporary verbal abatement on August 10, 2012. Mr. Cobb indicated that he would stop shooting per the abatement, but he did express the desire to speak with the Board of County Commissioners in the future about this issue.

To my knowledge, Mr. Cobb has abided by the abatement since the date it was issued. Further incidents involving the discharge of firearms at this location could result in a formal abatement issued by the Board of County Commissioners and an injunction from the Douglas County District Court.
