ITEM NO. 2: Consider request to establish YIELD signs at the intersection of 30th Street & Kensington Road.

Staff Report:

- 1. Guidelines for the installation of YIELD signs are contained in the *Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices* published by the Federal Highway Administration; however, none of the requirements for consideration are currently met.
- 2. Police Department records do not show any reported crashes at this intersection during the past three (3) years.
- 3. Traffic data collected November 4-5, 2013, found 85th percentile speeds on all four (4) approaches to be below the 30 mph speed limit.
- 4. If YIELD signs are installed, they should be installed on 30th Street, the lower volume street; this could have an unintended consequence of increasing the speed of traffic on Kensington Road.
- 5. New developments in the city are required to provide traffic calming circles at all 4-way intersections of "local" streets.
