ITEM NO. 5: Consider establishing a MULTI-WAY STOP at Overland Drive & Queens Road.

Staff Report:

1. A temporary Multi-Way Stop was installed at this intersection in August.
2. Overland Drive and Queens Road are both classified as "collector" streets.
3. With the opening of the Sports Pavilion Lawrence at Rock Chalk Park, traffic is expected to significantly increase on Overland Drive, including a Bus Route between the Pavilion and Wakarusa Drive.
4. Stop signs have been in place on Overland Drive, previously.
5. One of the criteria in the *Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices* for a Multi-Way Stop installation is, "Locations where a road user, after stopping, cannot see conflicting traffic and is not able to negotiate the intersection unless conflicting cross traffic is also required to stop."
