
RE: Accept a LiveWell Community Wellness Grant to fund Bike Repair Stands

#### **Summary**

The Douglas County Community Foundation awarded a LiveWell Community Wellness Grant in the amount of \$4,383 to the City of Lawrence to install 4 bike repair stands and air pumps throughout Lawrence.

#### Project Description

The City of Lawrence currently has one bike repair stand and air pump installed at Lawrence City Hall. There are two other known bike repair stands in Lawrence, at the community Mercantile and at the KU Ambler Student Recreation Fitness Center.



Four additional locations were identified to install the bike repair stands and air pumps: Burroughs Creek Trail parking on 15<sup>th</sup> Street (near playground), the North Lawrence Levy Trail Head Parking Lot, Rotary Arboretum Trail parking for SLT, and Library Plaza – near parking garage

Funding Breakdown: Four Bike Repair Stand and Pump (with shipping) - \$5,844 (Grant Awarded - \$4,383, Lawrence Public Works - \$1,461) Installation: Public Works Staff \$1,200 (InKind)

## Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends that the LiveWell Community Wellness Grant be accepted and the bike repair stands and pump installed.

### <u>Action</u>

Accept the \$4,383 LiveWell Community Wellness Grant funding and commit local match of \$1,461 and staff time to install the bike repair stands and pumps at the proposed locations.
