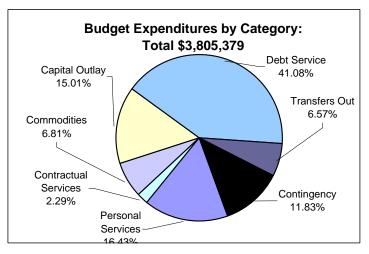

Expenditures - Descriptions and Trends

<u>Personal Services</u>- Cost of providing wages, salaries, retirement, and other fringe benefits for City employees and to some extent, part-time, seasonal staff. Increases in 2005 are due to projected merit increases for eligible employees, a 2% general wage adjustment, and implementation of the Primary Pay Plan. Additionally, the City's share of the per employee health care costs have increased for 2005.

<u>Debt Service</u>- Increases in Debt Service result from converting temporary financing for major construction projects to bonded debt at the completion of construction. From 2005 to 2009, the divison will pay debt service on two major phases of stormwater project construction.

<u>Transfer</u>- Increases in transfers to the General Fund will allow for additional funding for the Workers Comp reserve fund as well as an increase in funding of the curb repair program.
