Women's Transitional Care Services, Inc (WTCS) has been serving survivors of domestic violence and their children in Lawrence since 1976. WTCS provides safe shelter, a 24-hour crisis line, peer support groups, advocacy and a community education program. We are the sole provider of services focused on domestic violence survivors in the area (Douglas County). Our services are unique in that we strive to assist the women and children obtaining our services in gaining control over their lives. We empower them to make their own decisions.

The emergency shelter, 24-hour crisis line and community education are our primary services offered to Lawrence by WTCS. As of June 30, 2005, WTCS sheltered 122 women and 121 children, responded to 1,240 crisis calls and provided 98 public presentations with 1,560 participants in attendance.

Our 24-hour crisi line is vital to the Lawrence community to access our services and receive information about domestic violence as well as referrals.

The requested funding will be used to support our 24-hour crisis line which connects the community to our services and to information about domestic violence. WTCS must rely on the Lawrence community to support our work and is committed to diversifying our funding base.
