## Visit or Call the Lawrence Community Shelter (LCS)

LCS will be the first stop for guests looking to access shelter.

- Transportation: Use the free bus system to get to LCS.



## LCS will serve as the main access point for emergency shelter and resources.

Overflow shelters will be opened as needed, with transportation provided from LCS as long as conditions allow.

- Please start at LCS to connect with services. As overflow shelters open progressively, transportation will be provided to alternate locations.

## Additional Information

- City parks, recreation, and culture buildings will be available for safe warming during regular business hours.
- Do not delay accessing shelter. Those seeking shelter should start at LCS for guidance and support.
