Hazardous Waste Disposal for

Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generators and Kansas Small Quantity Generators

The Lawrence Waste Reduction & Recycling Division assists Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator and Kansas Small Quantity Generator (CESQG and KSQG) businesses with proper and affordable disposal of hazardous waste. Call **832-3030** for your waste inventory and disposal cost estimate.

A CESQG is a business that generates less than 55 pounds of hazardous waste, or less than 2.2 pounds of acutely hazardous waste in a calendar month. A KSQG business generates between 55 pounds and 220 pounds of hazardous waste, or less than 2.2 pounds of acutely hazardous waste in a calendar month. Don't know your hazardous waste generator status? Call the Kansas Department of Health & Environment at 842-4600.

Hazardous materials accepted include: paint, pesticides, thinners and other solvents, adhesives, industrial use cleaners, automotive products, batteries, aerosols, fluorescent and other mercury containing lamps, photographic chemical.

Hazardous materials NOT accepted: asbestos, ammunition, explosives, infectious waste (medical waste), radioactive waste, unknown materials (no labels).
