

Resolution No. 5437

A Resolution of the City of Lawrence, Kansas concerning the Recycling and Resource Conservation Board, repealing Resolutions No. 5288 and 5405.

WHEREAS, the Lawrence City Commission adopted Resolution No. 5288 on November 14, 1989 establishing the Recycling Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, the Lawrence City Commission amended Resolution No. 5288 with Resolution No. 5405 on April 2, 1991 concerning the membership and reporting requirements of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Lawrence City Commission desires to change the name of the board to the Recycling and Resource Conservation Advisory Board and create additional responsibilities for the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCE, KANSAS:

Section 1. The Lawrence City Commission hereby establishes the Recycling and Resource Conservation Advisory Board.

Section 2. The mission of the Lawrence Recycling and Resource Conservation Advisory Board is to support, strengthen and expand recycling and resource conservation activities and programs.

Section 3. The Mayor, with the advice and consent of the Lawrence City Commission, shall appoint a ten (10) member board which shall serve as a representative body for the community, and shall involve volunteers and community members.

Section 4. That the Lawrence Recycling and Resource Conservation Advisory Board shall advise the Lawrence City Commission and staff in the following ways. The Board should:

a. Monitor and review present recycling and resource conservation efforts.

b. Assist the Lawrence City Commission and staff to develop and establish goals and priorities for future recycling and resource conservation efforts.

c. Advise the Lawrence City Commission and staff on practical methods and programs to reach their goals for future recycling and resource conservation efforts.

d. Assist in advising the implementation of the Lawrence City Commission Task Force recommendations.


e. Serve as an information resource for the Lawrence City Commission and staff.

f. Receive reports on recycling and resource conservation from staff.


g. Report twice a year on recycling and resource conservation issues to the Lawrence City Commission, as well as regular communication to the recycling coordinator regarding Advisory Board activities.

Section 5. Resolutions No. 5288 and 5405 are hereby repealed it being the intent that this resolution supercede those resolutions.
