Frequently Asked Questions

I have questions about the program or my account. Who do I call?

Can I add, delete, or swap vehicles on my account?

You are welcome to add vehicles to your account at any time. You will need to pay the vehicle fee for the vehicle, and rates are not prorated.

You may delete a vehicle if you wish, but no refunds will be given.

If you wish to swap a vehicle, you can. If it's the same class or a lower class, there will be no additional charge. If it's a higher class, you will pay only the difference.

There's a long line at the compost facility during a public event. Can I go around it? No. We know that the line of cars can get pretty long during public City-load events. However, your access does not include bypassing these lines.

People aren't following the rules or there's something suspicious happening. What do I do?

Monitoring the facility and enforcing of the rules and regulations is not part of this agreement. You are not required to watch over the facility. Do not put yourself in a situation that could be dangerous by confronting anyone that may be doing something illegal or against the rules.

However, if you see something dangerous, suspicious, illegal, or otherwise concerning and would like to let someone know about it, you are welcome to do that. Any time of day, you can call the MSO office at 785-832-7800 and report what you have seen. If it's during business hours, they will call the police or let the appropriate staff know about it. If it's after hours, you will be connected with Reuschhoff Security, and they will make the appropriate calls.

If the matter is not urgent, you can email compost@lawrenceks.org and let staff know.

I see flames or smoke from one of the piles. What do I do?

If you see flames from one of the piles, you should leave immediately. Fires at compost facilities and wood lots can erupt and get dangerous very quickly. Once you are safe, please call 911. Again, you are not required to monitor our facility, but we would be very grateful if you report any flames that you see. If you do not want to call 911, you can call the MSO office at 785-832-7800 any time of day or night.

Smoke and steam can be hard to tell apart. If you're not sure which one it is, or if you smell smoke but don't see any flames, you can call the MSO office and they will pass on the message.
